





- **Sunday of Orthodoxy**– This year the Sunday of Orthodoxy Vespers will be held at St. Elias Orthodox Church in Atlanta. Please come if you are able. Vespers begins at 6pm and a free Lenten dinner will follow. 2045 Ponce de Leon Avenue, NE, Atlanta, GA 30307.
- **Presanctified Liturgy**– This week's Presanctified Liturgy will be on Wednesday evening. On Friday we will celebrate the Feast of the Annunciation in the morning and a Moleben to the Holy Cross on Friday evening. In order to receive the Eucharist at a Presanctified Liturgy, a fast from all foods is required for at least three hours before the service, which would be which be around 4PM.

We will be continuing this throughout lent this year. Remember that the dishes you bring are fasting dishes consisting of no meat and no dairy products. ***This week there is no potluck because there will be no Presanctified Liturgy on Friday evening!***
